Activity Sheet FISH TV

This activity sheet accompanies a matching video tutorial, use them individually or together to best suit you.



Ever wanted to be on TV? Well here is your chance, and you don't even need to leave the house! This guide will show you how to make your own TV where you can perform and delight your family with your exciting shows and amazing jokes!







You will need:

- 1 large cardboard box (big enough for you to get inside)
- Masking tape
- A sharp pencil
- A pair of strong scissors
- Colourful paints and felt pens

STEP 1



Few things are as exciting as the arrival of a big cardboard box, the possibilities are endless! For this activity however you do need a box large enough for you to get inside.

- Open the box but make sure that one end is sealed down, using masking tape if you need to. This will be the top of the TV.

STEP 2

- Turn the box on its side. On one side near the sealed end, draw a TV screen shape with a pencil or pen.

STEP 3



- Use the pencil or pen to punch a hole in each corner of the TV screen.
- Using a pair of scissors, insert them into one of the holes and cut out the screen following the lines you have drawn.

Remember!

You may need help from an adult if the cardboard is thick.

STEP 4

- Reinforce the inside edges of the screen with masking tape. This smooths them and also reduces the chance that the box might rip.

STEP 5

- Now you are ready for the creative part! Either start using your TV to perform straight away, or get decorating and turn it into an underwater masterpiece. Use your imagination and have fun!
